

Alan and Vivian Trethewey Youth Philanthropist Award Guidelines

Introduction

This award recognizes service by a young person or group of young people ages 12 to 23 who have demonstrated outstanding commitment to helping others through fundraising efforts and/or volunteering.

Award Criteria

- Funds raised and/or amount of volunteer time
- Leadership demonstrated
- If part of a group, ability to work as a team player

Additional Material:

Provide a letter of reference from the organization or individual or family that benefitted from the funds raised by the nominee or benefitted from the nominee's volunteer efforts.

The Award

The recipient will receive a certificate of the award and \$500 will be donated to the recipient's charity of choice.

Judging

The Community Grants Committee of the Abbotsford Community Foundation will select the recipient of the Alan and Vivian Trethewey Youth Philanthropist Award. Selection will be based on only the information contained in the Nomination Form. The committee may verify the information but will not seek out additional information. The successful nominee will be informed of the judging results no later than **Tuesday November 7, 2017**

Responsibilities

The recipient or representative of the recipient group must be prepared to speak at the National Philanthropy Day Luncheon about what they did to receive the award.

The runners up must be available to attend the National Philanthropy Day Luncheon on November 15, 2017 as the guests of the Abbotsford Community Foundation where they will be acknowledged but not required to speak.

The Alan and Vivian Trethewey Youth Philanthropist Award Nomination Form must be submitted online no later than **Monday October 16, 2017**. The letter of support and participation consent form must be forward by email to wendyneufeld@abbotsfordcf.org no later than **Monday October 23, 2017**.
