Abbotsford Cultural Centre (The Reach Gallery Museum Abbotsford

The Reach Art Engagement Kits

\$5,000

This program offers free Art Engagement Kits to children, youth and their families to provide hands-on, creative opportunities to learn about art and culture without the need for prior knowledge or experience with art.

Abby Community School Society

Summer Camp for Education and Recreation (SCAMPER)

\$10,000

This program provides a free, 5 week-long summer camp that improves reading proficiency, socialization, self-esteem and problem solving for grade 1-3 students who have been identified as at-risk for social and literacy difficulties.

Archway Community Services Society

Seva Food Pantry

\$15,000

This program will provide equitable access to nutritious and culturally appropriate food for ethnic minority families experience or at risk of poverty in Abbotsford.

Starfish Pack Program

The Starfish Pack program provides students in Kindergarten through grade 12 with weekend packs of breakfasts, lunches, dinners, and snacks, that are delivered directly to schools.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Fraser Valley

Mentoring for Mental Health – Trauma Informed Practice Training

\$15,000

Building upon the current Mentoring for Mental Health program in partnership by providing training in for all staff and mentors o ensure the most vulnerable children/youth are matched with mentors who have a solid foundation in Trauma Informed Care.

Board of Education

Back to School Event \$15,000

Provides local students from families experiencing financial hardship with the school supplies they require to be prepared to return to school. This includes school supplies, personal hygiene products, non-perishable food items, fresh produce and gift cards.

Canuck Place Children's Hospice

Counselling & Bereavement Services at Dave Lede House

\$5,000

Counselling and bereavement services to parents, siblings, and grandparents from diagnosis through the end of life of the child and beyond.

Care for Women

Care for Women Program – Community Outreach

\$10,000

To support 15 pregnant mothers and their babies with 1:1 dedicated volunteer mentorship, meals, cleaning, transportation and community resources for 11 months.

Breaking Down Barriers: Crisis & Counselling

\$15,000

Providing an immediate response to youth and families in crisis involved with Cyrus Centre by being able to have barrier- free access to mobile counselling services.

Fraser Valley Brain Injury Association

Young at Arts Summer Program

\$5,000

Young at Arts is a summer program/camp for children affected by acquired brain injury, directly themselves, their siblings or parents with an acquired brain injury.

Fraser Valley Down Syndrome Society

Social & Emotional Program

\$2,500

Offers free group activities for children, youth and adults with Down Syndrome to aid in their social and emotional development. Also offers family events at either low or no cost to foster friendships between those with Down Syndrome, as well as their families.

Fraser Valley Healthcare Foundation

Wifi for ARH Pediatrics Department

\$4,456.70

Providing expanded wifi access to Abbotsford Regional Hospital (ARH) Pediatric patients and their families. This will allow the young patients to access Disney+ and Netflix and also allow the parents to not worry about data usage when updating friends and family out of town or chatting with their own other children.

Skill Seekers Program

\$10,000

The program is a life skills and pre-employment program offering fine arts and culinary arts opportunities for persons with developmental disabilities.

\$15,000
